

Animal Import Requirement Q&A from the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP) Animal Health Division

Q: Has Wisconsin made changes to the import requirements due to the COVID-19 pandemic?

A: Currently Wisconsin has made non changes to import requirements for animals due to the COVID-19 situation. As far as I'm aware, other states' animal import regulations remain unchanged as well.

The Wisconsin Safer At Home Order, issued March 24, requires individuals to stay at home with certain exceptions for essential businesses and activities. In the order, animal shelters and rescues are listed as essential businesses.
