



"We're All In" Small Business Grant Application Open June 15-23

Gather Needed Documents Now to Streamline Process

The Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation (WEDC) will issue \$2,500 grants to 30,000 Wisconsin small businesses through the "We're All In" Small Business Grant Program. The program is funded by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act. You will be able to access the online grant application from 8 a.m. Monday, June 15, through 11:59 p.m. Tuesday, June 23.

To be eligible, your business must:

- be a Wisconsin-based, for-profit business;
- employ 20 or fewer full-time equivalent (FTE) employees, including the owner;
- earn greater than \$0 but less than \$1 million in annual revenues (gross sales and receipts); and
- have started operating prior to January 1, 2020, and have been in business as of February 2020.

Applicants are encouraged to gather the following required documents prior to the application period:

- A 2018 or 2019 federal tax return for business (If you started your business in 2020, you are not eligible for this grant);
- IRS form 1040 (sole proprietors) and the following:
 - Schedule C, Profit and Loss from Business;
- A signed W-9 and dated form available at www.irs.gov/pub/irs-pdf/fw9.pdf; and
- A letter or email of acknowledgement from a community organization indicating your business was in operation in February 2020.
